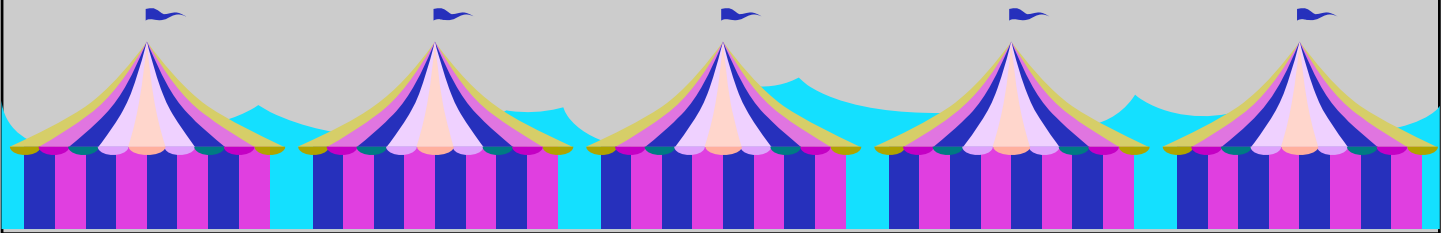
# Community Fair
